## A Storied Legacy and a Bright Future

When the building that would eventually become McCarthy Hall was first envisioned, Cal State Fullerton was not much more than a few temporary classrooms surrounded by orange groves.

When it was built between 1959 and 1963, the science building was considered a marvel of its time. Each of the six floors was nearly an acre. Combined with a full basement, the facility boasted about 300,000 square feet of classroom, office, lab and multipurpose space.


